Central America Choice Board

You have already chosen a country and found tons of information about it. Now the real work starts! Below you have a choice board. 2 of the choice are ones that are a requirement. (The postcard and creating a quiz) All you need to do is choose one other assignment for you to work on and complete. Choice board activities can be done with your time in class and at home. You will present each of the 3 assignments you complete to your class. Make sure you take your time and do it right the first time!

(<u>Must Do</u>) Create a postcard illustrating a physical feature in the country you have chosen. On the back, write to a friend or family member describing the physical feature and the climate it is located in.

Write and perform a song to help students learn or remember information that you studied in your country. (Examples: physical features, culture, climate, ect...)

Create a powerpoint journey to your country. Your powerpoint must have 10 slides, some key words or ideas, and present picture based information to the viewer about your country.

(<u>Must Do</u>) Create a quiz for your country. The quiz must be 20 questions long, have a combination of matching, multiple choice and short answer. Provide an answer key! Read and summarize a newspaper or magazine article about your country's environment or their culture. Please turn in summary and the article with it.

Create a comic strip story that describes to us something about their culture. You must have at least 10 frames (boxes) for your comic strip story.

Write a short story (2 pages) about a student from your country.
Remember, a story has an interesting beginning, an engaging problem, and a satisfying ending.

Create a poster to teach the information of your country. Include vocabulary words, along with pictures and information about the physical features and culture.
